



A SPECTACULAR 30TH YEAR FOR LEMIEUX AND PILON

Montreal, January 27, 2014 – The year 2014 marks a turning point in the artistic career of Michel Lemieux and Victor Pilon. And to celebrate 30 years of audacity, creativity and artistry, the duo is offering the public an array of opportunities to discover or rediscover their devised universe with four new projects.

To launch this exceptional year, Lemieux and Pilon are mounting a brand-new multimedia theatre piece at the Théâtre du Nouveau Monde, from January 14 to February 8. Written by Olivier Kemeid, *Icare* transposes the classical myth of Icarus to the contemporary world, where a father and son confront each other about buried truths and lost illusions. The show stars actors Renaud Lacelle-Bourdon and Robert Lalonde, mezzo-soprano Noëlla Huet, as well as Pascale Bussières, Maxime Denommée and Loïk Martineau, who are lending their talents to the virtual characters.

From March 27 to April 12, the now classic show *Norman* returns to the Cinquième salle of the Place des Arts to pay tribute to the pioneer of animated films, Norman McLaren. Combining performance and documentary, the production has enchanted the public at home and around the world, with stops in Paris, Austria, Mexico, Barcelona, Seoul and Scotland, the birthplace of the famous Canadian filmmaker.

NORMAN was a huge success and a magnificent project to produce with Michel Lemieux and Victor Pilon. We are remounting it for a third and final time at the Cinquième salle. Associating with artists of Michel and Victor's calibre, two incredibly talented visionaries, is hugely motivating for the Place des Arts team.

This film, produced in collaboration with ICI ARTV and Télé-Québec, will premiere at the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts this coming May prior to its television broadcast.

Since founding Lemieux Pilon 4D Art in 1983, Michel Lemieux and Victor Pilon have been combining their talents to produce hybrid productions that merge the real and the virtual in a unique amalgam of the performing arts and new media. Their productions, such as *La belle et la bête, The Tempest, Orfeo and Anima*, have been performed all over the world. The duo also created and directed several multimedia productions for other companies, including *Delirium* for Cirque du Soleil; the sold-out hit *Starmania: The Opera* for the Opéra de Québec and the Opéra de Montréal; and *Continuum*, celebrating the beauty of our universe, for Montreal's new Rio Tinto Planetarium, a Space for life, inaugurated in 2013. Lemieux and Pilon work has been seen all around the world by some 5,000,000 spectators.
